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**Re: Protest of Lease Parcels for the Utah Bureau of Land Management 2025 Quarter 4
Competitive Oil & Gas Lease Sale (DOI-BLM-UT-0000-2025-0003-EA)**

To Whom It May Concern:

Rocky Mountain Wild, The Coalition to Protect America's National Parks, and Natural Resources Defense Council respectfully protest the below-listed parcels in the Utah Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Fourth Quarter 2025 Competitive Oil and Gas Lease Sale. The reference identification for this lease sale is DOI-BLM-UT-0000-2025-0003-EA. On September 22, 2025, the BLM Utah State Office released the Environmental Assessment,¹ Finding of No Significant Impact,² and Notice of Competitive Lease Sale,³ offering 46 parcels containing 68,203.45 acres. For the reasons stated herein, our groups protest all 46 of the parcels.⁴

I. INTERESTS OF THE PROTESTING PARTIES

Our organizations have a long-standing interest in the management of BLM lands in Utah and engage frequently in the decision-making processes for land use planning and project proposals that could potentially affect our public lands and mineral estate, including the oil and gas leasing process and associated lease sales. Our members and staff enjoy myriad recreational, scientific, and other opportunities on BLM-managed public lands, including hiking, biking, nature-viewing, photography, and quiet contemplation in the solitude offered by wild places. Our missions are to work for the protection and enjoyment of the public lands for and by our members and the public.

Rocky Mountain Wild (RMW) is a non-profit conservation organization that works to protect, connect, and restore wildlife and wild lands in the Southern Rocky Mountain region. RMW envisions a biologically healthy future for our region – one that includes a diversity of species and ecosystems, thriving populations of wildlife, and a sustainable coexistence between people and nature. Using research, community science, legal action, and advanced geospatial analysis, we offer solutions for conserving our most at-risk animal and plant species and landscapes. We review and engage in BLM oil and gas lease sales with a goal of reducing the impacts of oil and gas leasing on wildlife and wildlands – such as the greater sage-grouse, ungulate populations, habitat for wildlife and lands with wilderness characteristics.

The Coalition to Protect America’s National Parks (Coalition) represents over 4,600 National Park Service (NPS) retirees, former and current employees, and volunteers, who collectively have more than 50,000 years of national park management and stewardship experience. The Coalition studies, educates, speaks, and acts for the preservation of America’s National Park System. Our membership includes former Park Service directors, regional directors, superintendents, resource specialists, rangers, maintenance and administrative staff, and a full array of other former employees, volunteers, and supporters. We have advocated for BLM oil and gas leasing reforms and commented on Bureau leasing proposals for a number of years due, in part, to the many adverse impacts that oil- and gas-based carbon emissions are having on irreplaceable natural and cultural resources across America's National Park System.

The Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC) is an international non-profit membership organization that works to safeguard the earth—its people, its plants and animals, and the natural systems on which all life depends. Founded in 1970, NRDC works to represent the interests of our more than 3 million members and online activists, including those who live in or visit Utah. Alongside frontline communities, NRDC has worked since its founding to safeguard this country’s critical natural resources using the best available science, data, and legal analysis. The keystone of this work has long been our advocacy to ensure resilient and thriving ecosystems across the landscapes managed by the federal government, particularly the BLM. We have a longstanding history of engaging in oil and gas leasing on public lands and land management planning.

II. STATEMENT OF REASONS IN SUPPORT OF THE PROTEST OF THE THIRD QUARTER 2025 COMPETITIVE OIL AND GAS LEASE SALE

The EA and FONSI contain several flaws that undergird this protest and counsel deferral of parcels from this lease sale, including but not limited to the following violations of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), the Federal Land Policy and Management Act (FLPMA), and the Administrative Procedure Act (APA):

- Leasing under the outdated Resource Management Plan (RMP) for the Vernal Field Office.
- Failing to explain the BLM’s change in position from considering deferring parcels in wildlife habitat to leasing all such parcels.
- Failing to adequately address the adverse effects on the greater sage-grouse and on ungulate species.

- Failing to adequately address the adverse effects on the Lower Bitter Creek Lands with Wilderness Characteristics (LWC) unit.
- Failing to comply with the BLM's own leasing regulations.
- Failing to adequately address the impacts of greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and climate change.
- Arbitrarily eliminating analysis of environmental justice.

a. The Trump administration's energy dominance agenda cannot override the BLM's statutory obligations under FLPMA and NEPA.

As we've raised in our previous comments on this lease sale, the BLM cannot justify leasing based on the alleged national energy emergency, as it has already attempted to do for this lease sale. *See* Draft EA at 7 ("On January 20, 2025, President Trump declared a national energy emergency due to the 'United States' insufficient energy production, transportation, refining, and generation [which] constitutes an unusual and extraordinary threat to our Nation's economy, national security, and foreign policy.' Executive Order 14156 – Declaring a National Energy Emergency. BLM Oil and Gas Leasing responds to this order."); *see also* EARTHJUSTICE ET AL., DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR EMERGENCY NEPA PROCEDURES (MAY 16, 2025) [Ex. 1]. The so-called "national energy emergency" declared in Executive Order 14156, 90 Fed. Reg. 8,433 (Jan. 29, 2025), is a transparent pretext to boost fossil fuel leasing and development in the absence of any apparent market-driven or national security based need to do so.

The BLM must analyze the deferral of lease parcels where conflicts with other uses exist. The Mineral Leasing Act (MLA) does not contravene the Federal Land Policy and Management Act's (FLPMA's) resource conservation requirements. Lands merely being designated as "open" for leasing under a particular Resource Management Plan (RMP) does not mean the BLM is required to lease them. Under FLPMA, the BLM must manage public lands according to "multiple use" and "sustained yield" and "in a manner that will protect the quality of scientific, scenic, historical, ecological, environmental, air and atmospheric, water resources, and archeological values." 43 U.S.C. §§ 1701(a)(7) & (8), 1712(c)(1), 1732(a). Multiple use obligates the agency to make the "most judicious use" of public lands and their resources to "best meet the present and future needs of the American people." *Id.* § 1702(c). This requires taking "into account the long-term needs of future generations," ensuring "harmonious and coordinated management of the various resources without permanent impairment of the productivity of the land and the quality of the environment." *Id.* Sustained yield mandates "achiev[ing] and maint[aining] in perpetuity . . . a high-level annual or regular periodic output of the various *renewable* resources of the public lands consistent with multiple use." *Id.* § 1702(h) (emphasis added). The BLM must "take any action necessary to prevent unnecessary and undue degradation of the lands." *Id.* § 1732(b). "It is past doubt that the principle of multiple use does not require BLM to prioritize development over other uses. . . . Development is a possible use, which BLM *must* weigh against other possible uses including conservation to protect environmental values. . . ." *New Mexico ex rel. Richardson v. BLM*, 565 F.3d 683, 710 (10th Cir. 2009) (emphasis added).

The BLM is therefore not obligated to lease any specific parcel of public land for oil and gas development. The agency retains the authority to defer any or all lease sale parcels, even after bidding has

concluded.⁵ Moreover, where conflicts with other uses exist, the agency must affirmatively evaluate deferral of parcels in its alternatives analysis under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

NEPA requires the BLM to evaluate the environmental impacts of this proposed lease sale. *See, e.g.*, 42 U.S.C. §§ 4331–4347. NEPA fosters informed decision making by federal agencies and promotes informed public participation in government decisions. *See Balt. Gas & Elec. Co. v. NRDC*, 462 U.S. 87, 97 (1983). To meet those goals, NEPA requires that the BLM “consider every significant aspect of the environmental impact of a proposed action” and inform the public of those impacts. *Id.* (internal citation omitted); *accord Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corp. v. Natural Resources Defense Council, Inc.*, 435 U.S. 519, 553 (1978).⁶ The BLM must take a “hard look” at the environmental effects before making any leasing decisions, ensuring “that the agency, in reaching its decision, will have available, and will carefully consider, detailed information concerning significant environmental impacts.” *Robertson v. Methow Valley Citizens Council*, 490 U.S. 332, 349–50 (1989). Environmental “[e]ffects are reasonably foreseeable if they are sufficiently likely to occur that a person of ordinary prudence would take [them] into account in reaching a decision.” *Sierra Club v. Fed. Energy Regulatory Comm’n*, 867 F.3d 1357, 1371 (D.C. Cir. 2017) (internal quotation omitted).

The BLM should grant this protest because the agency has failed to properly analyze and address resource conflicts and the environmental effects discussed below.

b. The BLM has failed to ensure that leasing is compliant with FLPMA.

FLPMA creates a framework governing the BLM’s management of public lands. *See* 43 U.S.C. §§ 1701–1772. It provides for management of public lands under principles of multiple use and sustained yield. *See id.* § 1732(a).

Land use plans or RMPs address both the present and future use of the land. The BLM uses RMPs to identify which areas will be open to oil and gas leasing and development. *See* 43 C.F.R. § 1601.0-5(n). RMPs establish, among other things, “[l]and areas for limited, restricted or exclusive use,” “[a]llowable

resource uses . . . and related levels of production or use to be maintained,” “[r]esource condition goals and objectives to be attained,” and “[p]rogram constraints and general management practices.” *Id.*; see 43 U.S.C. § 1712(a). FLPMA prohibits the BLM from taking actions inconsistent with the provisions of RMPs. See 43 U.S.C. § 1732(a); 43 C.F.R. § 1610.5-3(a) (“All future resource management authorizations and actions . . . shall conform to the approved plan.”).

RMPs may grant the BLM authority to lease in certain areas. See 30 U.S.C. § 226(b)(1)(A); 43 C.F.R. § 3120.1-2(a). Before issuing leases, however, the agency must confirm that the applicable RMP is up to date and that the underlying environmental analysis will support a contemporary leasing decision. If an RMP is more than five years old, the BLM must reevaluate and confirm that the analysis and any underlying assumptions remain valid. See 42 U.S.C. § 4336b. An RMP would no longer support a new leasing decision if important new data, policies, or changed circumstances exist that were not considered when it was approved. See H-1601-1 — LAND USE PLANNING HANDBOOK, SECTION VII.C, DETERMINING WHEN IT IS NECESSARY TO REVISE AN RMP; 43 C.F.R. § 1610.5-6. If an RMP is too old or stale to support a new leasing decision, the BLM must revise the RMP or undertake a new, thorough environmental analysis to support new leasing, such as an EIS.

The Vernal RMP is old and stale, including as evidenced by its failure to adequately account for or address the environmental impacts on resources and land uses due to climate change. The RMP does not contain any discussion of climate change or GHG emissions. As a result, the BLM should not be leasing in this field office at this time.

In its response to comments received on the Draft EA for this sale regarding this issue, the BLM simply defers to the short sections in the Draft EA that address BLM land use plan conformance and the proposed lease sale’s relationship to statutes, regulations, policies, and other plans. See Draft EA, Response to Comment O-2c at 33 (“Please see sections 1.4 and 1.5 for a description of how the EA complies with FLPMA and other statu[t]es, regulations and policies.”). Neither section, however, acknowledges the age of the Vernal RMP and the environmental analyses that are missing from it, or how either of those issues affect the BLM’s ability to properly manage public lands and make leasing decisions.

As such, we are protesting all 46 parcels in this lease sale.

c. The BLM has failed to properly analyze impacts to greater sage-grouse, and failed to prioritize leasing outside sage-grouse habitat.

This lease sale includes parcels that overlap General Habitat Management Areas (GHMAs) for the greater sage-grouse. The Draft EA considers an alternative for this lease sale whereby the BLM would not offer the entirety of 39 parcels (UT-2025-12-1602, -1603, -1617, -1618, -1620, -1622, -1625, -1626, -1627, -1634, -1640, -1641, -1643, -1644, -1645, -1650, -1655, -1657, -1658, -1660, -7723, -7727, -7728, -7733, -7731, -7734, -7735, -7738, -7739, -7740, -7746, -7753, -7758, -7759, -7760, -7762, -7763, -7764, and -7771) that overlap GHMA, yet, the BLM is not deferring any of these parcels. Since the release of the Draft EA, the agency has not provided any additional analysis to support the decision to not be moving forward with the Greater Sage-Grouse Alternative at this time. Moreover, the BLM has failed to properly

analyze the adverse effects of leasing these parcels in sage-grouse habitat, or to prioritize leasing outside of that habitat. The BLM's decision contravenes the 2015 Greater Sage-Grouse Resource Management Plan Amendments (the 2015 Plans) and subsequent court decisions, along with violating FLPMA, NEPA, and the APA.

The agency has “specifically identified ‘oil and gas development’ as a ‘major threat’ to sage-grouse habitat.” *Mont. Wildlife Fed’n*, 127 F.4th at 43. Previous similar lease sale analysis of sage-grouse impacts has been found to violate NEPA. *See Wilderness Soc’y v. U.S. Dep’t of the Interior*, No. 22-cv-1871 (CRC), 2024 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 51011, at *62 (D.D.C. Mar. 22, 2024). In *Wilderness Soc’y*, the district court recognized that BLM’s practice of simply claiming that impacts from leases will be “similar” to those discussed in the NEPA documents for the 2015 Plans falls short of what the law requires. *See id.* at *54–62. Instead, the NEPA analysis must address the *specific* lands being offered and develop a “prediction of how this lease sale will likely impact sage grouse populations in light of all available evidence, including the more recent science that has motivated [the BLM] to redraft the existing [2015 Plans].” *Id.* at *17; *see Western Watersheds Project v. Bernhardt*, 543 F. Supp. 3d 958, 991–93 (D. Idaho 2021).

A key component of the 2015 Plans requires the BLM to prioritize new oil and gas leasing outside of PHMA and GHMA to protect that habitat from future disturbance. The Ninth Circuit recently affirmed that “the government must take an affirmative role in encouraging oil and gas leasing in non-sage-grouse habitat.” *Mont. Wildlife Fed’n*, 127 F.4th at 45. The BLM’s national policy addressing prioritization, IM 2018-026, has been struck down. *See Mont. Wildlife Fed’n v. Bernhardt*, No. 18-cv-69-GF-BMM, 2020 WL 2615631 (D. Mont. May 22, 2020), *aff’d*, 127 F.4th 1 (9th Cir. 2025). The agency has not adopted new national guidance on the prioritization requirement and has represented to the U.S. Montana District Court that the agency’s previous prioritization guidance (adopted in 2016) also is not in effect. As a result, there is currently no national guidance providing direction on how prioritization is to be applied.

What is clear is that the BLM cannot merely “respond to industry expressions of interest.... in leasing specific land parcels,” but rather it must undertake “independent agency determinations of which parcels to offer for oil and gas leases.” *Wilderness Soc’y*, U.S. App. LEXIS 1106, at 69. In addition to prioritizing leasing away from PHMA, the agency must also guide leasing away from GHMA lands.

In March 2021, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) researchers released a report that provides one of the most comprehensive population trend modeling efforts ever undertaken for sage-grouse. *See* PETER S. COATES ET AL., RANGE-WIDE GREATER SAGE-GROUSE HIERARCHICAL MONITORING FRAMEWORK: IMPLICATIONS FOR DEFINING POPULATION BOUNDARIES, TREND ESTIMATION, AND A TARGETED ANNUAL WARNING SYSTEM (March 2021) [Ex. 2], <https://doi.org/10.3133/ofr20201154>. The report reveals that since 1965, sage-grouse populations have declined 80% range-wide, including in areas less affected by the decline. *See id.* at 29. Since 2002, range-wide populations have declined 37%. *See id.* at 3. Also, 78% of leks have a greater than 50% probability of extirpation in the next 56 years. *See id.* at 52, 90. In September 2022, the USGS and other federal agencies released a report that found 1.3 million acres of sage-grouse habitat are transitioning each year from largely intact sagebrush sites to less functioning sagebrush habitat. *See* KEVIN DOHERTY ET AL., A SAGEBRUSH CONSERVATION DESIGN TO PROACTIVELY RESTORE AMERICA’S

SAGEBRUSH BIOME: U.S. GEOLOGICAL SURVEY OPEN-FILE REPORT 2022–1081, 28 (Sept. 22, 2022) [Ex. 3], <https://pubs.usgs.gov/of/2022/1081/ofr20221081.pdf>.

The science makes clear that the BLM’s focus must be to “stop the bleeding” on sage-grouse population losses. *See Wilderness Soc’y*, No. 22-cv-1871 (CRC), 2024 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 51011, at *59. The BLM must conduct a proper analysis of effects to the sage-grouse. Its failure to properly do so for this sale and its failure to defer parcels in sage-grouse habitat violates FLPMA, NEPA, and the APA.

As we raised previously, the Draft EA identifies parcels 1622, 1626, 1627, 1634, 1655, 1657, 1658, 1660, 7723, 7733, 7734, 7735, 7738, 7740, 7746, and 7771 as having low preference for leasing, based on the presence of greater biological components and fewer fluid mineral components. *See* Draft EA at Appendix H, 136. The remaining twenty-three parcels, UT-2025-12-1602, 1603, 1617, 1618, 1620, 1625, 1640, 1641, 1643, 1644, 1645, 1650, 7727, 7728, 7731, 7739, 7753, 7758, 7759, 7760, 7762, 7763, and 7764, are identified as having higher priority for leasing “because they are generally where fewer biological component(s) are present, and more than one fluid mineral component is also present.” *See id.* at 137. This latter determination is arbitrary, based only on a very brief analysis of each parcel’s biological and fluid mineral components without adequate consideration having been given to the reasonably foreseeable individual and cumulative impacts of leasing within the East Bench/Book Cliffs GHMA. It is apparent that the Draft EA has foregone this analysis in favor of identifying these twenty-three parcels as having high priority for leasing based on the surrounding areas having a relatively high percentage of lands already under lease and held by production as well as having high oil and gas potential. *See id.*

The Draft EA’s analysis of impacts to sage-grouse from leasing is limited to cursory statements: “Influences of oil and gas development on GRSBG can include direct mortality from impact with infrastructure or vehicles, short term impacts associated with direct habitat loss and behavioral avoidance, and long-term impacts on grouse behavior and demographics. Oil and gas development can contribute to declines in lek persistence and male attendance, yearling and adult hen survival, and nest initiation rates miles from the source of disturbance. Oil and gas wells elicit strong avoidance response in yearling age classes, nesting/brooding hens, and wintering birds.” *See* Draft EA at 100. These statements do nothing more than “inform [the BLM] and the public what they already know.” *WildEarth Guardians v. BLM*, 457 F. Supp. 3d 880, 886 (D. Mont. 2020). Such “general statements” do not substitute for evaluating the foreseeable impacts. *See Or. Nat. Desert Ass’n v. Rose*, 921 F.3d 1185, 1191 (9th Cir. 2019). Without some meaningful analysis, the BLM has no basis for its conclusion that “the effects of oil and gas development and its related infrastructure on GRSBG have been thoroughly addressed in land use plan amendments.” *See* Draft EA at 100. The BLM “must do more to justify its conclusion that the effects would be the same as those outlined in the RMPs.” *Wilderness Soc’y*, No. 22-cv-1871 (CRC), 2024 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 51011, at *60.

The Draft EA also offers almost no discussion of new scientific evidence since the 2015 sage-grouse plans were issued. The limited information the EA does provide underscores the concern about inadequacy of the BLM’s conservation efforts. Additionally, the Draft EA fails to address how BLM’s anticipated revisions to the sage-grouse plans would affect development of these leases.

The BLM's decision to offer parcels in GHMA violates both the 2015 Plans and the agency's own regulations. It is also arbitrary and capricious because the BLM has not adequately explained its apparent rejection of the Greater Sage-Grouse Alternative. Parcels in GHMA that we protest include the following:

d. The BLM has failed to properly analyze leasing parcels in big game habitat.

The BLM is not deferring any parcels due to overlap with big game crucial winter range. Pursuant to its regulations, the agency must preference “lands that would not impair the proper functioning of [fish and wildlife] habitats or corridors.” 43 C.F.R. § 3120.32(b). Nonetheless, the Draft EA designates all these parcels as having a high preference for leasing.

The Draft EA’s analysis of impacts to big game species is wholly inadequate. The Draft EA simply states that “[u]nmitigated energy production is likely to have adverse effects on big game species, including loss of habitat from construction of roads and production facilities including usable habitat near roads, habitat fragmentation, increased noise and disturbance from human activities, and possible collisions causing direct mortality.” See Draft EA at 68. Rather than provide even perfunctory discussion of reasonably foreseeable impacts to big game populations from oil and gas leasing and reasonably foreseeable development on leased parcels, the BLM has foregone any meaningful analysis in favor of only applying timing limitation stipulations. See Draft EA at 68-69.

FLPMA requires the BLM to manage public lands “in a manner that will provide food and habitat” for all wildlife. 43 U.S.C. § 1701(a)(8). Research makes clear that big game suffer considerable losses from leasing and development on their critical winter range. See, e.g., Adele K. Reinking et al., *Across Scales, Pronghorn Select Sagebrush, Avoid fences, and Show Negative Responses to Anthropogenic Features in Winter*, 10(5) ECOSPHERE 1, 1–14 (May 2019) [Ex. 4],

<https://esajournals.onlinelibrary.wiley.com/doi/epdf/10.1002/ecs2.2722>. Peer-reviewed research has demonstrated that mule deer respond unfavorably to oil and gas development in migratory habitats, often missing out on high-quality forage during the spring migration. See Ellen O. Aikens et al., *Industrial energy development decouples ungulate migration from the green wave*, 6 NATURE ECOLOGY & EVOLUTION 1733, 1733–1741 (Oct. 2022) [Ex. 5], <https://doi.org/10.1038/s41559-022-01887-9>.

Extensive leasing in crucial winter range or migration corridors have significant adverse impacts on Utah’s big game herds. See Utah Division of Wildlife Resources, Department of Natural Resources, Utah Mule Deer Statewide Management Plan 2025-30, 10 (November 2024) [Ex. 6], https://wildlife.utah.gov/public_meetings/rac_minutes/2024-11-mule-deer-statewide-management-plan-2025-30.pdf.

Mitigation is insufficient. Mitigating impacts through stipulations is not the same as avoidance. See, e.g., *Mont. Wildlife Fed’n*, 127 F.4th at 44 (explaining that imposing stipulations is distinct from avoiding leasing and development outside sage-grouse habitat). The mitigation hierarchy sequences avoidance as the first line of defense. See Dep’t of the Interior, Dep’t Manual: Implementing Mitigation at the Landscape-scale 1, 3 (Oct. 23, 2015). Leasing parcels in big game habitat and migration corridors is in direct contradiction to the purpose of the leasing preference criteria, which is to *avoid* adverse resource impacts. Stipulations are inadequate to avoid significant impacts in crucial winter habitat and migration corridors.

In addition, because leasing is an irreversible and irretrievable commitment of resources, the BLM may not defer detailed analysis until the permitting stage. Federal courts have repeatedly rejected agency attempts to avoid analyzing reasonably foreseeable future impacts by claiming that considering them at

the lease sale stage would be speculative. *See, e.g., Northern Plains Res. Council, Inc. v. Surface Transportation Board*, 668 F.3d 1067, 1078–79 (9th Cir. 2011) (“Because speculation is implicit in NEPA, we must reject any attempt by agencies to shirk their responsibilities under NEPA labeling any and all discussion of future environmental effects as crystal ball inquiry.” (quotations and alternations omitted)). A court recently rejected this rationale precisely for analyzing impacts from leasing on the sage-grouse, explaining that the BLM “cannot escape” proper analysis at the leasing stage “by claiming that a more precise analysis is not feasible and promising a more probing review of the site-specific effects at the APD stage.” *Wilderness Soc’y*, No. 22-cv-1871 (CRC), 2024 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 51011, at *61 (quotation marks omitted).

Finally, the EA’s reliance on lease stipulations and notices is unwarranted considering the frequency with which the BLM grants industry applications for exemptions from protective stipulations. For example, between January 1, 2018 and February 1, 2023, BLM field offices in Wyoming granted approximately 90% of the 127 waivers that oil and gas companies applied for in order to conduct industry activities in areas that have been set aside to protect sage-grouse and migratory raptors. *See* Public Employees for Environmental Responsibility (PEER), “BLM Oil Exemptions Threaten Sage Grouse in Wyoming” (Mar. 8, 2023), <https://peer.org/blm-oil-exemptions-threaten-sage-grouse-wyoming/>; *see also* PEER, GREATER SAGE GROUSE - PROTECTION EXCEPTION REQUESTS: BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT, WYOMING 1/1/18 - 2/1/23 (Feb. 17, 2023) [Ex. 7], https://peer.org/wp-content/uploads/2023/03/3_7_23_Spreadsheet-Wyoming-Sage-Grouse-Consultations-2.17.23.pdf. With how routinely the BLM grants these exceptions with no public process and no analysis of cumulative effects, the BLM cannot claim that the attachment of stipulations and lease notices at the leasing stage sufficiently addresses reasonably foreseeable impacts to big game habitat. Deferring habitat protections to mitigative action that may be taken at a future date is not only imprudent, but also duplicitous considering recent action that the Interior Department has taken with respect to permitting.

For the above reasons, the Draft EA fails to justify leasing in crucial habitat for big game. The BLM’s failure to conduct a proper analysis of effects to big game for this sale and its failure to defer parcels overlapping big game habitat violates FLPMA, NEPA, and the APA. Parcels overlapping big game habitat that we protest include the following:

e. The BLM has failed to properly analyze leasing parcels overlapping the Lower Bitter Creek Lands with Wilderness Characteristics (LWC) unit.

FLPMA obligates the BLM to take its resource inventory into account when preparing management plans and authorizing uses, observing the principles of multiple use and sustained yield. *See* 43 U.S.C. §§ 1711(a), 1712(c); *Ore. Natural Desert Ass’n v. Bureau of Land Mgmt.*, 625 F.3d 1092, 1122 (9th Cir. 2008). The BLM is also required to “prevent unnecessary or undue degradation to wildlife and other public lands and values.” 43 U.S.C. § 1732(b).

In making decisions about leasing areas for oil and gas development, the BLM can and should protect wildlife, scenic values, recreation opportunities, and wilderness character on public lands. This is necessary and consistent with the definition of multiple use, which identifies the importance of various aspects of wilderness characteristics (such as recreation, wildlife, and natural scenic values) and requires

the BLM's consideration of the relative values of these resources but "not necessarily to the combination of uses that will give the greatest economic return." *Id.* § 1702(c).

This lease sale includes parcels that overlap the Lower Bitter Creek LWC unit. While it is true that LWC inventory findings are a resource determination and do not compel protection, the BLM must preserve its ability to decide whether and how to protectively manage wilderness resources in a public planning process.

The Draft EA provides only generalized information regarding the indirect and direct impacts to wilderness characteristics that the issuance of oil and gas leases can cause, ultimately leading to increased levels of noise, light pollution, air pollution, potential water pollution, altered viewshed, depreciated apparent naturalness, and reduction in opportunities for solitude and primitive recreation. The Draft EA claims that these impacts would be "temporary and localized," but there is a lack of adequate analysis provided to support that conclusion. The Draft EA's brief mention of the areas around parcels overlapping the Lower Bitter Creek LWC unit possessing "a high degree of topographic and auditory screening due to steep ridges, deep washes, and generally broken terrain" does not provide enough site-specific evidence to support the use of stipulations alone to sufficiently mitigate the impact of "intense" development activity on the wilderness character of the lands.

For these reasons, the Draft EA fails to justify leasing lands overlapping the Lower Bitter Creek LWC unit. The BLM's failure to conduct a proper analysis of effects to wilderness character from leasing and its failure to defer parcels overlapping lands with wilderness character violates FLPMA, NEPA, and the APA. Moreover, continuing to lease in the Lower Bitter Creek area increases the likelihood that the BLM will decline to manage for wilderness characteristics based on the significant presence of existing oil and gas leases in the area, as evidenced previously in the 2008 Approved RMP for the Vernal Field Office. *See* BLM-UT-PL-09-003-1610, at 33-34 (Oct. 31, 2008).

Parcels overlapping the Lower Bitter Creek LWC unit that we protest include the following:

f. The BLM has failed to properly analyze greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions and climate effects and factor GHG emissions and climate effects into its leasing decisions.

The EA fails to properly consider GHG emissions and their effect on climate change. The BLM must not only properly analyze and quantify the direct, indirect, and cumulative GHG emissions and climate impacts that may result from leasing, but it must also factor GHG emissions into its leasing decisions. *See Wilderness Soc'y*, No. 22-cv-1871 (CRC), 2024 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 51011, at *91. The agency must consider GHG analysis when making its decision on a lease sale. As one court explained: "Any claim that the analysis of GHG emissions was informational only and did not inform BLM's decision-making is hard to square with [NEPA's] purpose." *Id.* at *87. The agency must also consider unquantified effects, recognize the worldwide and long-range character of climate change impacts, and incorporate this

analysis of ecological information into its environmental analysis. *See* 42 U.S.C. §§ 4332(2)(A), (B), (D), (I) & (K). The BLM has the tools to undertake this analysis but has failed to do so here.

The MLA requires the Secretary of the Interior to lease lands for oil and gas development only in the public interest. *See* 30 U.S.C. § 192. In its NEPA analysis, the BLM can and must consider adverse effects to health and the environment—part of the public interest—when determining whether to lease. *See* 43 U.S.C. § 1732(b) (requiring the BLM to prevent unnecessary and undue degradation); *cf. Sierra Club v. Fed. Energy Regulatory Comm’n*, 867 F.3d at 1373–74 (explaining that whether an agency must analyze certain environmental effects under NEPA turns on the question, “What factors can [the agency] consider when regulating in its proper sphere,” and holding that the agency must consider direct and indirect environmental effects because the statute at issue indeed vested the agency with authority to deny the project based on harm to the environment (internal quotation marks omitted)). Such adverse environmental effects include those caused by GHG emissions associated with prospective development of these parcels and their impacts on the climate.

Court decisions clearly establish that NEPA mandates consideration and analysis of the indirect and cumulative climate impacts of BLM fossil fuel production decisions, including at the leasing stage.⁷ The BLM must ensure it fully considers not only the GHG emissions from prospective wells drilled on the leases sold at this lease sale—and the climate change impacts of those GHG emissions—but also the impacts of other federal lease sales in the state, region, and nation, as well as impacts from GHG emissions from non-Federal sources. The BLM must consider GHG emissions in the aggregate along with other foreseeable emissions. Such analysis is necessary to meet the cumulative impacts demands of NEPA.

The indirect and cumulative impacts must be given meaningful context, including within carbon budgets, rather than simply dismissed as insignificant compared to national or global total GHG emissions. *See*,

Supp. 3d 41, 63, 67–77 (D.D.C. 2019) (invalidating nine BLM NEPA analyses in support of oil and gas lease sales because “BLM did not take a hard look at drilling-related and downstream [greenhouse gas] emissions from the leased parcels and, it failed to sufficiently compare those emissions to regional and national emissions”). The Supreme Court’s recent decision in *Seven County Infrastructure Coalition v. Eagle County*, 605 U.S. at ___, Slip Op. (May 29, 2025), does not alter the BLM’s NEPA obligations to analyze GHG emissions and climate impacts for this lease sale. *Seven County* affirmed that agencies must still analyze indirect effects under NEPA. *See* Slip Op. at 16. The downstream GHG emissions that will result from this lease sale are indirect effects that require analysis. By controlling the oil and gas leasing process, the BLM possesses regulatory authority over managing the oil or gas subject to the prospective leasehold. *Cf. id.* at 4 (“[T]he Board possesses no authority or control over potential future oil and gas development in the Basin.” (citation modified)) & 4 (Sotomayor, J., concurring in judgment) (“[T]he Board cannot control the products transported on the proposed rail line.” (citation modified)). The oil or gas to be extracted is directly related to the leases at issue and thus not too proximately separate in time or place. *See id.* at 15–18. As such, under a rule of reason, the BLM must analyze the GHG emissions that would result because it manages and exerts authority over the oil or gas, which is directly related to this lease sale. *See id.* at 16 (“To be clear, the environmental effects of the project at issue may fall within NEPA even if those effects might extend outside the geographical territory of the project or might materialize later in time” (emphasis in original)). Thus, the BLM’s response to comments that it has “no authority or control over . . . downstream actions,” BLM, WYOMING RESPONSE TO PUBLIC COMMENTS at *40, is incorrect.

e.g., *WildEarth Guardians*, 368 F. Supp. 3d at 77. “Without establishing the baseline conditions . . . there is simply no way to determine what effect the proposed [action] will have on the environment and, consequently, no way to comply with NEPA.” *Half Moon Bay Fisherman’s Marketing Ass’n v. Carlucci*, 857 F.2d 505, 510 (9th Cir. 1988). Excluding climate change effects from the environmental baseline ignores the reality that the impacts of proposed actions must be evaluated based on the already deteriorating, climate-impacted state of the resources, ecosystems, human communities, and structures that will be affected. The BLM’s climate effects analysis “must give a realistic evaluation of the total impacts and cannot isolate a proposed project, viewing it in a vacuum.” *Grand Canyon Trust v. Fed. Aviation Admin.*, 290 F.3d 339, 342 (D.C. Cir. 2002).⁸

The tons of GHGs emitted by a project are not the “actual environmental effects” under NEPA. Merely listing the quantity of emissions is insufficient if the agency “does not reveal the meaning of those impacts in terms of human health or other environmental values,” since “it is not releases of [pollution] that Congress wanted disclosed” but rather “the effects, or environmental significance, of those releases.” *NRDC v. NRC*, 685 F.2d 459, 486–87 (D.C. Cir. 1982), *rev’d on other grounds*, *Balt. Gas & Elec. Co.*, 462 U.S. at 106–07. In other words, the actual effects and relevant factors that must be analyzed and disclosed to the public are the incremental climate impacts caused by a project’s GHG emissions, including: property lost or damaged by sea-level rise; changes in energy demand; lost productivity and other impacts to agriculture; and human health impacts, such as cardiovascular and respiratory mortality from heat-related illnesses, changing disease vectors like malaria and dengue fever, increased diarrhea, and changes in associated pollution. These impacts are all included to some degree in the different assessment models included in SC-GHG estimates. *See, e.g., ENV’T PROT. AGENCY, REPORT ON THE SOCIAL COST OF GREENHOUSE GASES: ESTIMATES INCORPORATING RECENT SCIENTIFIC ADVANCES* 47–62 (2023) [Ex. 8] [hereinafter GREENHOUSE GAS REPORT].

Even in combination with a general, qualitative discussion of climate change, by calculating only the tons of GHGs emitted, an agency fails to meaningfully assess the actual incremental impacts to property, human health, productivity, and so forth.⁹ An agency therefore falls short of its legal obligations and

⁸ *See also Great Basin Mine Watch v. Hanks*, 456 F.3d 955, 973–74 (9th Cir. 2006) (holding agency’s cumulative impacts analysis insufficient based on failure to discuss other mining projects in the region); *Kern v. ⁹ *See Ctr. for Biological Diversity*, 538 F.3d at 1216–17 (rejecting analysis under NEPA when agency “quantifie[d] the expected amount of [carbon dioxide] emitted” but failed to “evaluate the incremental impact that these emissions will have on climate change or on the environment more generally,” noting that this approach impermissibly failed to “discuss the actual environmental effects resulting from those emissions” or “provide the necessary contextual information about the cumulative and incremental environmental impacts” that NEPA requires); *California v. Bernhardt*, 472 F. Supp. 3d 573, 623 (N.D. Cal. 2020) (“[F]raming sources as less than 1% of global emissions is dishonest and a prescription for climate disaster . . . Mere quantification [of greenhouse gas emissions] is insufficient.”); *Mont. Env’tl. Info. Ctr. v. U.S. Office of Surface Mining*, 274 F. Supp. 3d 1074, 1096–99 (D. Mont. 2017) (rejecting the argument that the agency “reasonably considered the impact of greenhouse gas emissions by quantifying the emissions which would be released if the [coal] mine expansion is approved, and comparing that amount to the net emissions of the United States”); *High Country Conservation Advocs. v. United States Forest Serv.*, 52 F. Supp. 3d 1174, 1191 (D. Colo. 2014) (“Beyond quantifying the amount of emissions relative to state and national

statutory objectives by disclosing only volume estimates. To take an analogous example, courts have held that just quantifying the acres of timber to be harvested or the miles of road to be constructed does not constitute a “description of *actual* environmental effects,” even when paired with a qualitative “list of environmental concerns such as air quality, water quality, and endangered species,” when the agency fails to assess “the degree that each factor will be impacted.”¹⁰

Monetizing climate damages using the SC-GHG helps the agency assess the incremental and actual effects bearing on the public interest. SC-GHG calculates how the emission of an additional unit of GHG affects atmospheric greenhouse concentrations, how that change in atmospheric concentrations changes temperature, and how that change in temperature incrementally contributes to economic damages, including property damages, energy demand effects, lost agricultural productivity, human mortality and morbidity, lost ecosystem services and non-market amenities, and others. *See, e.g.*, INTERAGENCY WORKING GRP. ON SOC. COST OF CARBON, TECHNICAL SUPPORT DOCUMENT: SOCIAL COST OF CARBON FOR REGULATORY IMPACT ANALYSIS 5 (2010) [Ex. 9]. The SC-GHG therefore captures the factors that actually affect public welfare and assesses the degree of impact to each factor, in ways that simply estimating the volume of emissions cannot.

The Interior Department had “adopt[ed] . . . [the EPA’s] new estimates of the social cost as the best available science.” 90 Fed. Reg. 4779, 4779 (Jan. 16, 2025); *see* U.S. DEP’T OF THE INTERIOR, INFORMATIONAL MEMORANDUM ON DOI COMPARISON OF AVAILABLE ESTIMATES OF SOCIAL COST OF GREENHOUSE GASES (SC-GHG), at 1, 8 (Oct. 16, 2024) [Ex. 10], https://eplanning.blm.gov/public_projects/2036015/200638053/20126874/251026854/20241016.DOI%20SC_GHG%20Info%20Memo.pdf (directing the BLM to “adopt the EPA’s 2023 estimates of the Social Cost of Greenhouse Gases (SC-GHG) as the best available science (as of September 30, 2024)”). However, the BLM is now omitting SC-GHG from its environmental analysis. For example, in a final Environmental Assessment (EA) for the Quarter 1 2025 New Mexico Oil and Gas Lease Sale, the BLM chose to omit its quantification of climate impacts (which had been included in the draft EA), did not replace this omission with any other adequate quantitative analysis, and purported to rescind its memorandum. *See* BLM, CARLSBAD FIELD OFFICE OIL AND GAS LEASE SALE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT at 88, QUARTER 1 (2025). But the BLM failed to provide proper justification for changing its position. *Cf. FCC v. Fox TV Stations, Inc.*, 556 U.S. 502, 515 (2009) (holding that an agency must provide “good reasons” for a change in position and must provide “a more detailed justification” when a “new policy rests upon factual findings that contradict those which underlay [an agency’s] prior policy; or when its prior policy has engendered serious reliance interests that must be taken into account”). The BLM’s only apparent substantive justification for not including such quantification is that “costs attributed to GHGs are often so variable and uncertain that they are unhelpful for the BLM’s analysis.” BLM, FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT: 2025 THIRD QUARTER COMPETITIVE LEASE SALE: DOI-BLM-WY-0000-2025-0001-EA, at *7 (Apr. 2025).

emissions and giving general discussion to the impacts of global climate change, [the agencies] did not discuss the impacts caused by these emissions.”).

That bare contention, with no reference or explanation to support it, is insufficient to justify a change in position. The Office of Information and Regulatory Affairs' (OIRA's) May 5, 2025, memorandum¹¹ directing agencies to minimize consideration of climate impacts likewise contains deeply flawed reasoning that cannot support failure to use SC-GHG. For years and over multiple projects, the BLM has quantified climate impacts, primarily relying on the well-supported SC-GHG estimates. *See, e.g.*, BLM, ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT: WYOMING 2023 SECOND QUARTER COMPETITIVE LEASE SALE at 54–55 (2023). Contrary to the BLM's justification for not using SC-GHG, the tool's estimates are based on extensive expert development and peer review for nearly two decades. *See, e.g.*, PETER HOWARD ET AL., INSTITUTE FOR POLICY INTEGRITY, ZERO RATIONALITY: WHAT OIRA'S NEW MEMORANDUM GETS WRONG ON MONETIZING CLIMATE IMPACTS at i (May 2025) [Ex. 11] [hereinafter ZERO RATIONALITY].

The Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA's) 2023 SC-GHG report underwent public comment and peer review by eminently qualified experts. *See, e.g.*, ENV'T PROT. AGENCY, DETAILS OF EXTERNAL PEER REVIEW PANEL PROCESS FOR THE REVIEW OF EPA'S "REPORT ON THE SOCIAL COST OF GREENHOUSE GASES: ESTIMATES INCORPORATING RECENT SCIENTIFIC ADVANCES" 2–4 (2023) [Ex. 12] (listing peer reviewers). EPA valued climate impacts using the best available scientific information, such as state-of-the-art damage functions from leading climate economists and research laboratories: one from the University of Chicago's Climate Impact Lab; one from Resources for the Future and the University of California, Berkeley; and one from Dr. Thomas Sterner and Dr. Peter Howard that integrates and combines many other published estimates through a meta-analysis. *See* GREENHOUSE GAS REPORT at 47. Collectively, these three damage functions capture various market and non-market damages caused by climate change, including impacts on health, energy, labor productivity, agriculture, and coastal regions. *Id.* at 52 Table 2.3.1, 55 Table 2.3.2. The choice to combine three independently constructed damage functions also helped ensure rigor by incorporating a range of expert analyses and thereby guarding against overreliance on any one methodology. Subsequently, numerous federal agencies (including DOI, as noted above) assessed EPA's updated estimates and determined that the updated estimates reflect the best available science on monetizing GHG emissions. *See* OFFICE OF MGMT. & BUDGET, REPORT TO CONGRESS ON THE BENEFITS AND COSTS OF FEDERAL REGULATIONS AND AGENCY COMPLIANCE WITH THE UNFUNDED MANDATES REFORM ACT: FISCAL YEAR 2023 at 21–22 & n.52 (2024) [Ex. 13], <https://bidenwhitehouse.archives.gov/wp-content/uploads/2025/01/FY23-Benefit-Cost-Report.pdf>.

Moreover, federal courts have repeatedly recognized that agency analysis necessitates making predictive judgments under uncertain conditions, explaining that “[r]egulators by nature work under conditions of serious uncertainty” *Pub. Citizen v. Fed. Motor Carrier Safety Admin.*, 374 F.3d 1209, 1221 (D.C. Cir. 2004) and “are often called upon to confront difficult administrative problems armed with imperfect data.” *Mont. Wilderness Ass’n v. McAllister*, 666 F.3d 549, 559 (9th Cir. 2011). As the Ninth Circuit has

explained, “the proper response” to the problem of uncertain information is not for the agency to ignore the issue but rather “for the [agency] to do the best it can with the data it has.” *Id.*

Experts have also accounted for uncertainty in SC-GHG estimation in rigorous ways. In developing its SC-GHG estimates, for example, EPA applied three damage models developed by different experts, *see* GREENHOUSE GAS REPORT at 2, incorporated a range of probabilistic socioeconomic and emissions scenarios, *see id.* at 21–33, and applied a series of climate-impact models that account for numerous sources of uncertainty. *See id.* at 33–44. To combine these different modules, EPA “incorporate[d] a quantitative consideration of uncertainty into all modules and use a Monte Carlo approach that captures the compounding uncertainties across modules.” *See id.* at 2. And while this approach produced a range of estimates, EPA provided average estimates at different discount rates including a “central” discount rate of 2%. *See id.* At 12. Accordingly, EPA both rigorously accounted for uncertainty and provided a single central SC-GHG estimate that regulators can apply, and the Working Group, in its estimates, did so as well. *See* ZERO RATIONALITY at 3–4.

Failing to properly quantify climate impacts in this process is arbitrary and capricious. The BLM must also make a significance determination based on GHG emissions and climate impacts.

Finally, NEPA requires agencies to “identify and develop methods and procedures . . . which will ensure that presently unquantified environmental amenities and values may be given appropriate consideration in decision making along with economic and technical considerations.” 42 U.S.C. § 4332(2)(B). A livable climate is a “presently unquantified environmental amenit[y].” By neglecting to use SC-GHG, the BLM would be failing to “identify and develop methods and procedures” to ensure that this “presently unquantified environmental . . . value” is “given appropriate consideration in decisionmaking.”

Therefore, the BLM must not only analyze GHG emissions. It must also address how GHG emissions inform its leasing decisions. “[T]he complexity of the task does not give the [BLM] a free pass to avoid making these tough decisions by asserting that GHG emissions did not factor into its decision-making.” *Wilderness Soc’y*, No. 22-cv-1871 (CRC), 2024 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 51011, at *91. The BLM “must . . . explain how its GHG analysis inform[s] the decision to select” its preferred alternative. *Id.* at *91–92. If the BLM does “not consider GHG emissions when rendering its decision . . . it would . . . overlook[] what is widely regarded as the most pressing environmental threat facing the world today.” *Id.*, No. 22-cv-1871 (CRC), 2024 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 51011, at *87–88. Here, the BLM has failed to explain how GHG emissions estimated to result from leasing factored into its decision-making.

g. The EA fails to analyze the impacts of oil and gas leasing on environmental justice.

The BLM fails to take a hard look at environmental justice. The EA does not once even mention “environmental justice.” Courts have repeatedly held that agencies must take a hard look at environmental justice pursuant to NEPA.¹² The BLM fails to explain this change in position from previous lease sale

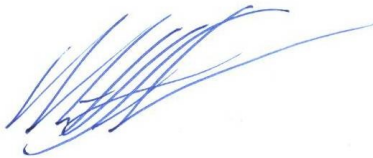
analyses that discussed the adverse effects of oil and gas activity on environmental justice communities, and the BLM's response to comments raised previously on this issue for this sale is insufficient for actually addressing how this failure comports with NEPA. The agency's failure to include this analysis in the EA is arbitrary and capricious both because it has failed to explain its change in position and because, by ignoring environmental justice, the agency has failed to consider an important part of the problem.
